



An Scoil - The School

Cuireadh Scoil Gheimhridh Frankie Kennedy ar bun i mí na Nollag 1994 i ndiaidh a bháis ó áilse i Meán Fómhair na bliana céanna. ‘Sé aidhm na Scoile leanstan ar aghaidh leis an fhuinneamh agus an spiorad a chuir Frankie sa cheol traidisiúnta agus forbairt a dhéanamh air, go mór mór ceol agus amhránaíocht Dhún na nGall.

The Frankie Kennedy Winter School was established in December 1994 following Frankie’s untimely death from cancer in September of that year. The school’s vision is to continue his huge contribution to Irish traditional music, especially the music and song of Donegal.

Tá muid ag brath go trom ar chabhair agus cuidiú ónár gcairde uilig, go háirithe na daoine áitiúla a chuidíonn go mór linn le buanú agus le heagrú na Scoile i rith na bliana - gan sibh, ní bheadh an Scoil ann - go raibh míle maith agaibh uilig. Frankie

Bhí Frankie Kennedy, a rugadh i mBéal Feirste 1955, aitheanta mar dhuine de fhliútdóirí móra na hÉireann sa cheol traidisiúnta de bharr a chuid oibre leis an bhanna ceoil ‘Altan’ a bhunaigh sé féin agus Mairéad ní Mhaonaigh, agus a raibh sé mar bhainisteoir air. Leag Frankie agus Mairéad an dúshraith don bhanna lena gcéad cheimín ‘Ceol Aduaidh’ a h-eisíodh ar lipéad Gael Linn.

Múinteoir céimiúil ab é Frankie agus comhráitf breá. Ba bhall é de dhream óg de fhliútdóirí díograsacha as an Tuaisceart a tháinig chun tosaigh sna seachtóidí agus na h-ochtóidí. Cosúil lena chairde, fuair Frankie spreagadh agus inspioráid dona chuid ceoil ó sheancheoltóirí agus amhránaithe Chúige Uladh.

Frankie Kennedy, born in Belfast in 1955, became one of Ireland’s best known traditional flute players through his work with the band Altan which he managed and founded with his partner Mairéad Ní Mhaonaigh. Frankie and Mairéad set the seeds for Altan with their ground breaking album Ceol Aduaidh on the Gael Linn label.

Frankie, a naturally gifted teacher and communicator, was part of a robust wave of young Northern flute players who came to the fore in the ’70s & ’80s. Like his contemporaries, Frankie drew inspiration from the older generation of Ulster musicians and singers.

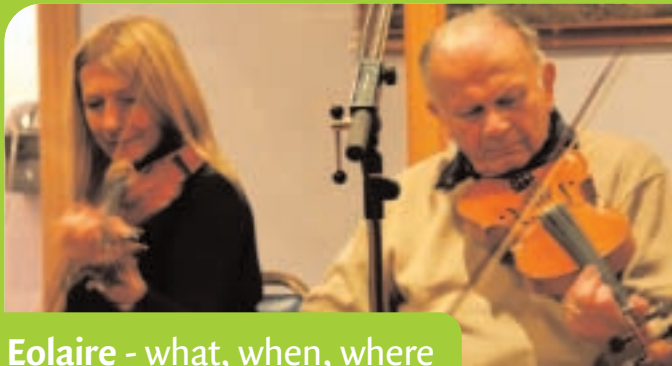

I mbliana beidh **Scoil Gheimhridh Frankie Kennedy** ag toiseacht Dé Máirt 27ú Nollag 2005 agus ag leanstan ar aghaidh go dtí Dé Luain 2ú Eanáir 2006. Beidh na himeachtaí uilig ag tarlú i nGaoth Dobhair, Co. Dhún na nGall agus beidh dhá ionad á n-usáid: Ionad Cois Locha i nDún Lúiche agus Ostán Gaoth Dobhair i Machaire Clochair.

This year's **Frankie Kennedy Winter School** will take place from Tuesday, 27th December 2005 until Monday 2nd January 2006. All the events will take place in Gaoth Dobhair, Co Donegal. We will be using 2 principal venues during the school, the Dunlewey Lakeside Centre in Dunlewey and Ostán Gaoth Dobhair in Magheraclogher.

Classes will be provided in the following: flute, fiddle, uilleann pipes, tin whistle, bodhrán, button accordion, sean nós singing, house dancing and accompaniment (guitar/bouzouki). Classes are not suitable for beginners. Students are encouraged to bring recording devices to the class.

Beidh mór-cheoltóirí na hÉireann ar an ardán in Ionad Cois Locha: ina measc beidh rí na bhfidléirí **Seán Keane** (Chieftains) agus rí na bpíobairí **Liam O'Flynn**; beidh scoith an cheoil ar ghiotár, fidil agus banjo le **Arty McGlynn** & **John Carty**; d'éisigh **Ciarán Tourish** (Altan) CD úr i mbliana agus beidh Ciarán ag seinm le **Seán Óg Potts**, **Jimmy Higgins** agus **Arty McGlynn**; agus beidh oíche go maidin san Ostán oíche Chinn Bliana le **Beoga**, **Seamus Begley** agus **Jim Murray**. Ar ndóigh ní Scoil Gheimhridh gan **Altan**! Beidh dhá choirmecheoil le hAltan agus aoínna speisialta mar chlabhsúr ar an Scoil i mbliana. Gach tráthnóna mar is gnách beidh ceolchoirmeacha san Ostán le leithéidí **Gay**, **Conor** agus **Seán McKeon**, **Arty McGlynn**, **Martin McGinley** agus fidléirí Connallaigh agus cuirfidh **Harry Bradley** agus fliútdóirí iontacha eile buaic ar an chlár le seisiún an-speisialta in omós agus i gcumhne Frankie Kennedy.

Bíonn an-tóir ar fad ar thicéidí i gcónaí - dá bhrí sin is fiú duit áirithint a dhéanamh a luaithe agus thig leat. Tá cosc iomlán ar thaifead nó craolachán a dhéanamh ar na himeachtaí seo gan cead a fháil roimhré.

This year's concert programme at Dunlewey has a world class line up including the virtuoso duet of **Seán Keane** (Chieftains) and **Liam O'Flynn**. Seán and Liam have brought Irish traditional music to audiences all over the world and have been key figures in seminal Irish bands including Ceoltóirí Chualann, Planxty, and the Chieftains.

Master guitarist **Arty McGlynn** has excelled in the fields of rock, country, jazz and traditional music. His technique and musicianship are revered internationally and he is one of the most sought after accompanists on the scene today. Arty teams up with Roscommon fiddle and banjo player **John Carty**.

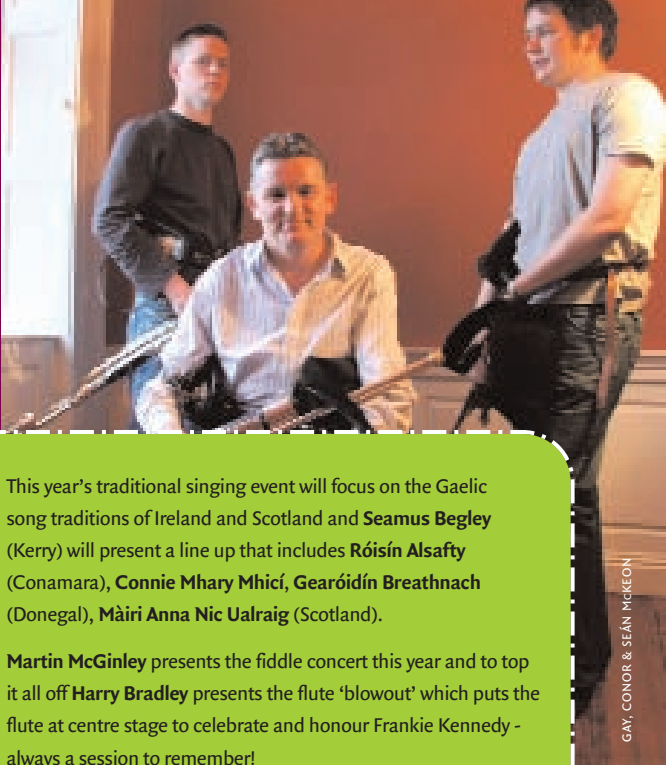


ALTAN
